



# Security Seminar & Exercise Series

- A collaborative effort between DHS and industry stakeholders aimed at fostering communication between facilities and their local emergency response teams by encouraging representatives to share their insight, knowledge, and experiences during a facilitated tabletop exercise.



# Voluntary Chemical Assessment Tool

- A secure, web-based, vulnerability assessment tool designed for use by the chemical industry. The tool allows owners and operators to identify their facility's current risk level using an all-hazards approach.
- Guides personnel through assessment of security, safety, and operation issues while incorporating sector expertise and experience into an automated model.
- Allows users to rate chemical assets and critical assets, characterize threats and hazards, and quantify vulnerability by assessing controls.
- Enables users to identify critical communications and cyber assets.
- Provides a practical cost benefit analysis option for recommended security practices.



# Chemical Security Awareness Training

- An interactive tool available free to chemical facilities nationwide to increase security awareness. The training is designed for all facility employees.
